As you can tell there are many great adventures wait you by branching out, packing up and moving out with your radio mike in hand.

I too have picked up the Bug to operate mobile. Like Glen has mentioned it really is not too difficult to accomplish. I however ended up trying a different approach to going Mobile. I started out just seeing what it was like buying a Ham stick and mounting on my truck taking my Kenwood TS440 from the shack and running a power line to the truck battery. Voila I was mobile. This experiment worked and I was now officially in the Utah capital on the air. The next step was to expand into other bands and take the show on the road. It seemed at first, the best I could do was operate and make contacts

on 40M of course it was the summer months where 40 is at its best (so to speak) I kept trying. We had some vacations planned so I added the radios to the mix and away we went. The National park award was created and that gave the YL an excuse to go on more trips. We were both on board for that one and we planned some trips to the best NP in the nation here in Utah. It wasn't long before I had enough contacts for the nomad award it really wasn't hard. But I was still having trouble getting on 75M but I kept on trying. The next few vacations involved flying across the nation. Hmmm now what can I do? I wouldn't have my own truck where I could mount just about any antenna. I would be limited to a rental car of their choosing. I decided that I would not be actually moving while making contacts so I could use a mag. Mount for the Ham stick. Next was the issue of a power connection. I decided to use the lighter plug. With all the preparations made I headed off to Florida one of our favorite vacation destinations. This first attempt like most experiments did not go too well. With out good ground on the antenna mount adapter I ended up with a lot of RF back into the rig. Also the lighter outlet was limited in the amount of power output. Still I made about a dozen contacts not too bad. What I learned from this experiment was I needed a smaller and lighter Rig and a better antenna mount and another power connection. I purchased a used Icom 706 a small and compact rig that seemed to fit the bill. Next, I found a small lip mount for the ham stick. And finally I found and built a two-wire cable that attached directly to the battery of the car. This time I think I had every thing worked out. The next trip to FL we traveled light and only checked our beach bag (the one I use to pack the antennas) the radio came on the carry on. Checking the TSA website they said Radios did not need to be removed from luggage. Little did I know that Ham radios were considered electronic Equipment and had to go through by itself like all lap tops. Another lesson learned. Finally arriving back in FL the equipment performed well. The band conditions on the other hand did not I still only made a few contacts the only on 40M I was having difficulty with 75M. With a major trip to the north east planned in a couple of months I was beginning to wonder what more I could do to get better results while mobile.

Finally the day came. I had my trusty radio and gear ready to go. Loaded up with my club and special event I headed out. For nearly two weeks I spent my nights sitting in the car eagerly listening to the static and attempting to make calls from the Northeastern part of Our great country. With the help of a few Great stations that help relay for me I was finally able to make many mobile contacts

I was even able to finally meet one of my good friends Dave, WN1F face to face and he helped me work a few stations on 80M RTTY mobile from his great Mobile Digital Station. Like many others, I became interested in radio when I was a child. I was on vacation with my parents. My uncle came to visit and he had a new set of walkie-talkies which, of course, my brother and I offered to test for him. During our extensive testing, that involved crawling around in the long grass, one of the antennas got broken. During my repeated apologies, all I could think of was how neat it was to be hundreds of feet away from my brother and yet still be able to communicate with him. This lead to CB radios when I was in grade school. In high school, my interest in electronics and communications peaked and after high school I entered an Electronics Engineering Technology college program. It was during the second year at college in 1983 when I first became licensed as VO2AM operating portable in VE3. For several years I was very active operating in VO2, VO1, and VE3. filling in the 2K Award, then 1K Award and finally the 500 Point Award applications. In taking this approach, you would not inadvertently use (waste) a difficult state on the 500 Point Award. Hey that makes sense. This guy must know what he's talking about. The last contact I needed was a DX contact on 75M SSB and this came when I worked PJ7UQ on July 3, 2010 for my 4798th contact. The Poker Player Award was also difficult and thank to KI4WCQ for bringing WV0U to the net.

When it comes to thanking folks, I am not sure where to start or end. There are so many truly wonderful people out there and I feel very grateful to be part of the Century Club. I do want to thank the Bureau managers Richard, Gene and Ron. 5000 contacts means 10,000 cards processed WOW super job guys. Election 2011


