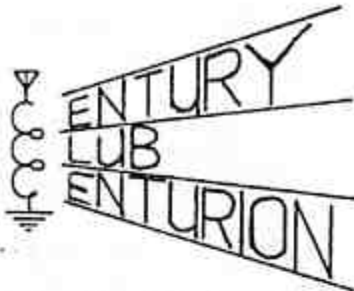

The Helping Hand

One of the forms I developed several years ago provided me with the chance to made the most effective use of my calls when my turn came. This form is included with this issue of the "Centurion". One side (horizontal orientation) has spaces for 20 states (the "ST" column) and the other one (vertical) has spaces for 21 states.

The Date and the Station Worked columns are pretty much self-explanatory. The other three columns allow you to write in whatever award that contact signifies (CAPS, YL's, Combo's, Mobiles, or whatever). It could also be used to indicate QSL's sent and received. Feel free to copy it and use it however you would like!
