

This guide describes the steps necessary to move logged contact data from NetLogger to N7XG.

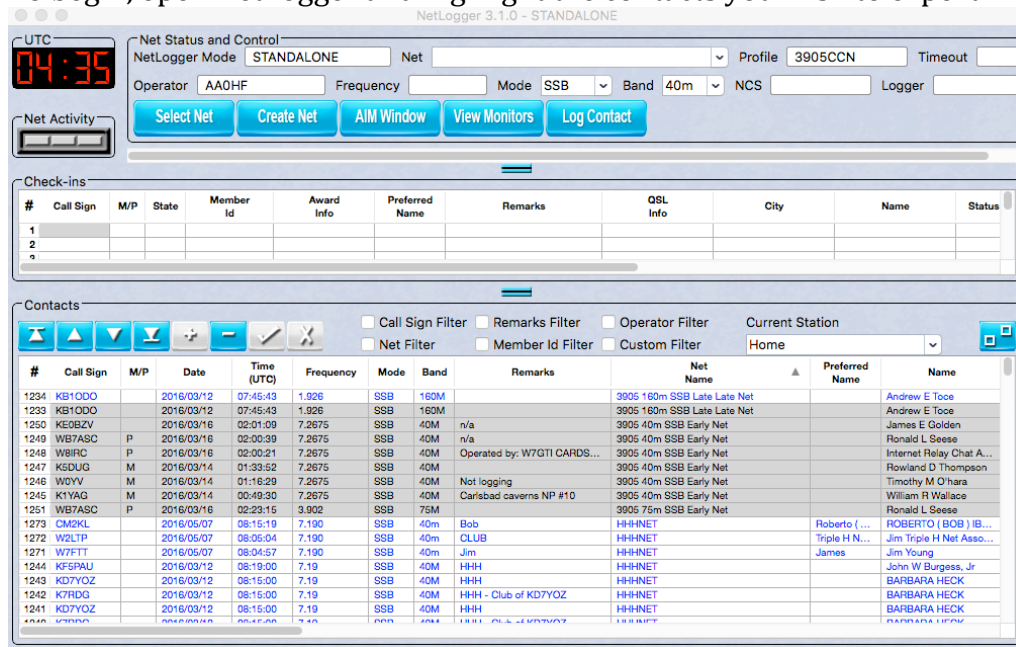
Requirements:

- N7XG Logger 5.02.03 or higher
- NetLogger version 3.1.4 or higher

Be sure to back up any existing N7XG logged contact data before beginning.

1. Create an ADIF text file containing your logged contact data stored in the NetLogger. Perform the following steps:

a. To begin, open NetLogger and highlight the contacts you wish to export.

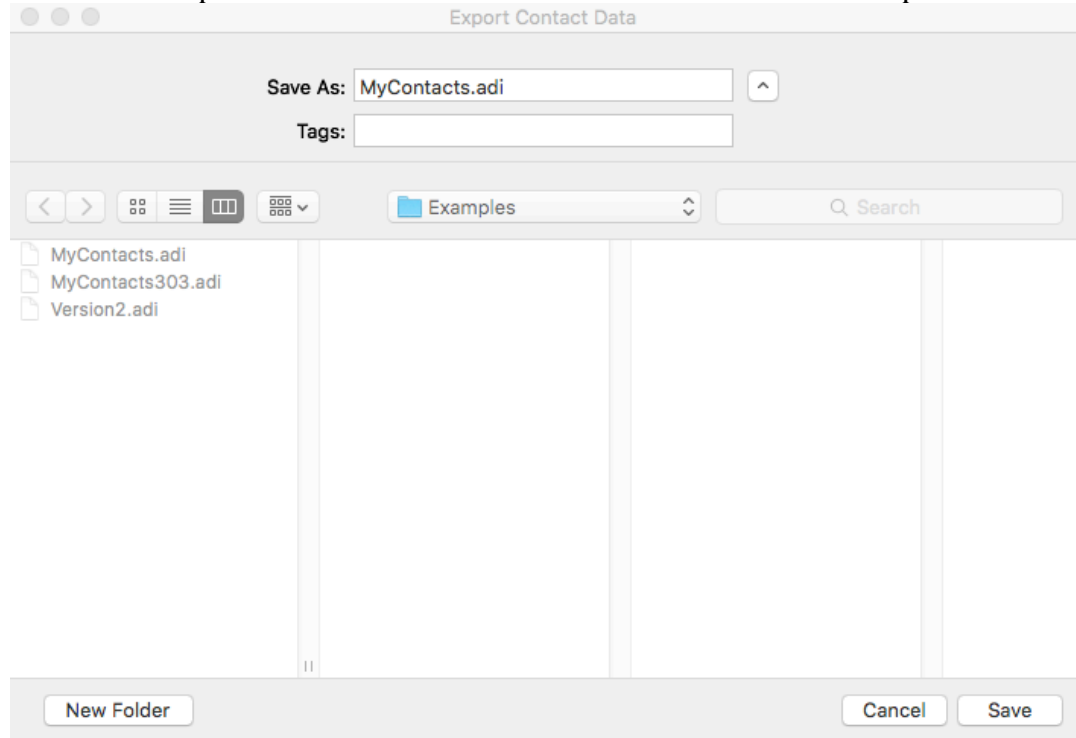


b. Next, from the File menu select Export, To ADIF File, Selected Contacts:

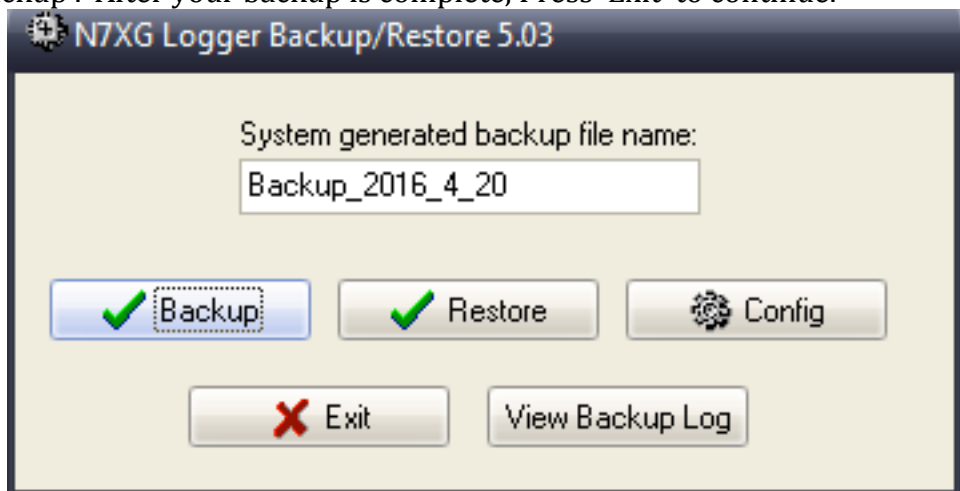

- c. Enter the name of the file you would like to use to store your contacts and choose the directory in which to save them. We suggest saving your files on the Desktop. Press 'Save' to continue. Your contacts will be exported.



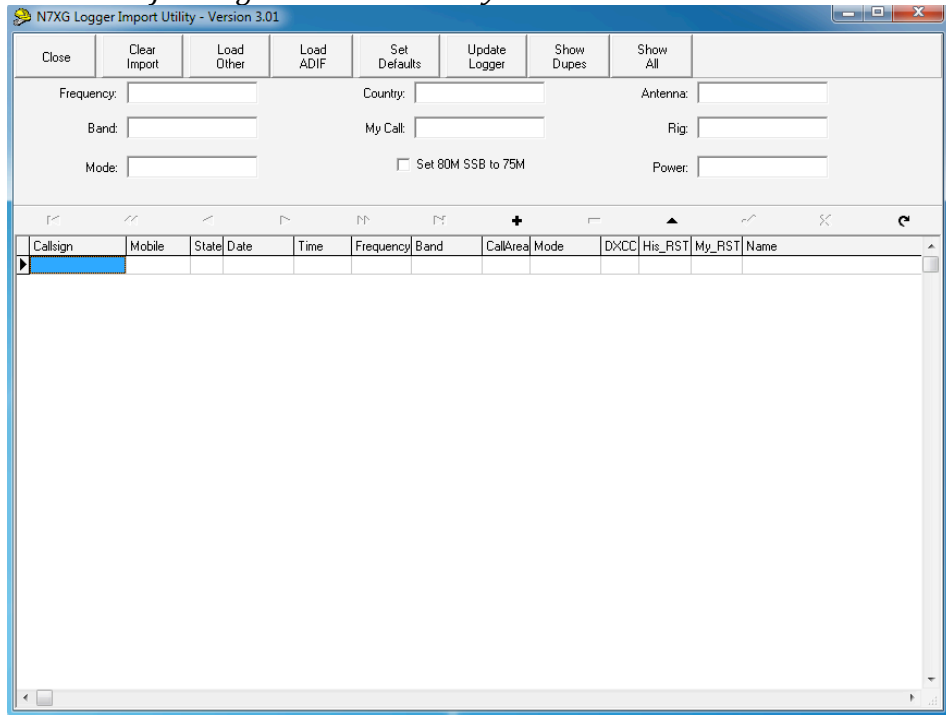
- d. You may now close NetLogger.

- 2. Import your contacts into the N7XG logger. Perform the following steps:
 - a. Run the N7XG backup utility. Save any existing contacts by clicking 'Backup'. After your backup is complete, Press 'Exit' to continue.

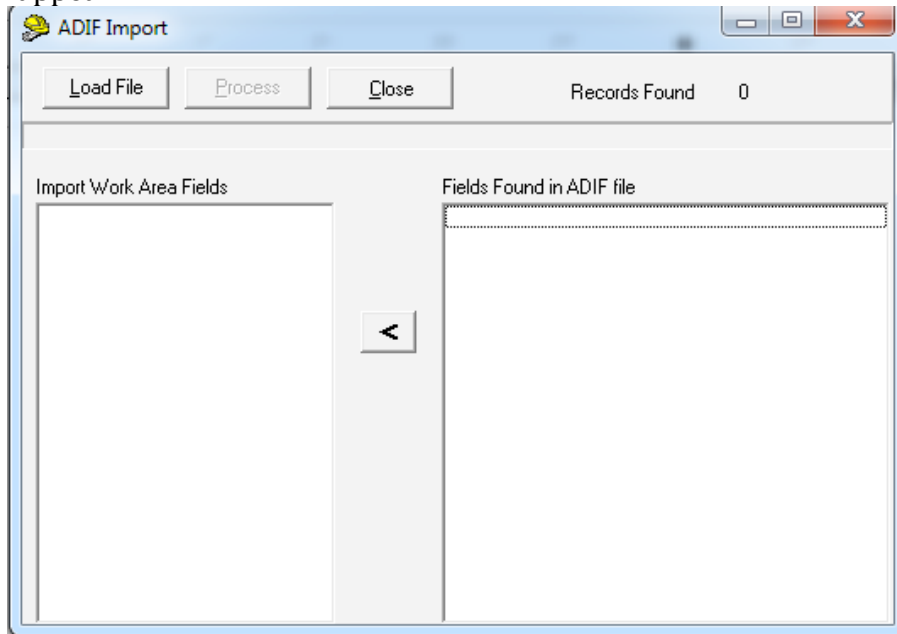


- b. Next, start the N7XG Log Conversion Utility. It is a standalone utility found in your N7XG install directory. The banner at the top of the screen should read N7XG Logger Import Utility version 3.02 or higher.

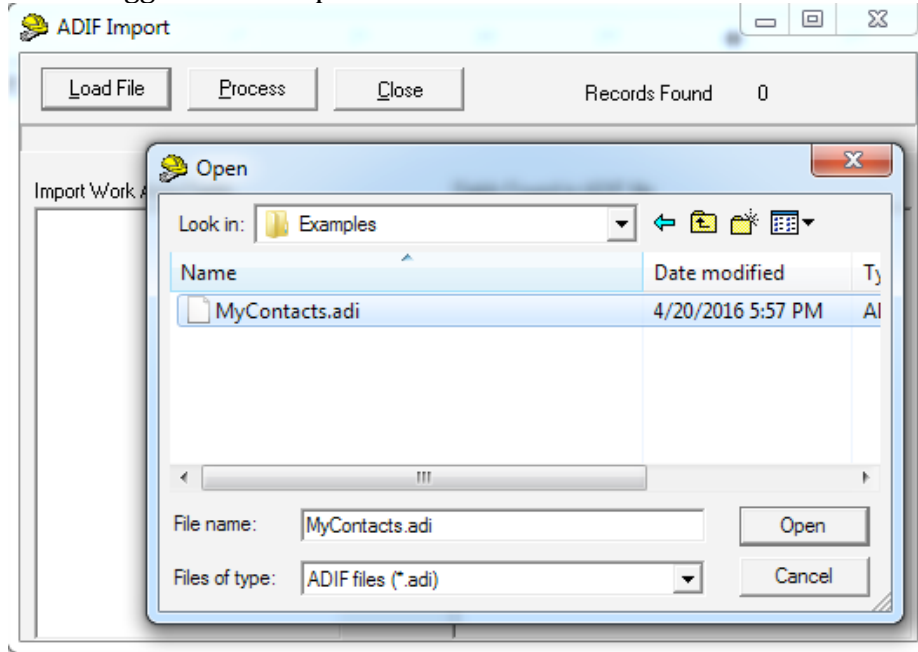
Note: If you have trouble finding the utility, click on the windows logo at the bottom left of your screen and in the search window type 'Log' and look for 'Log Conversion Utility.'



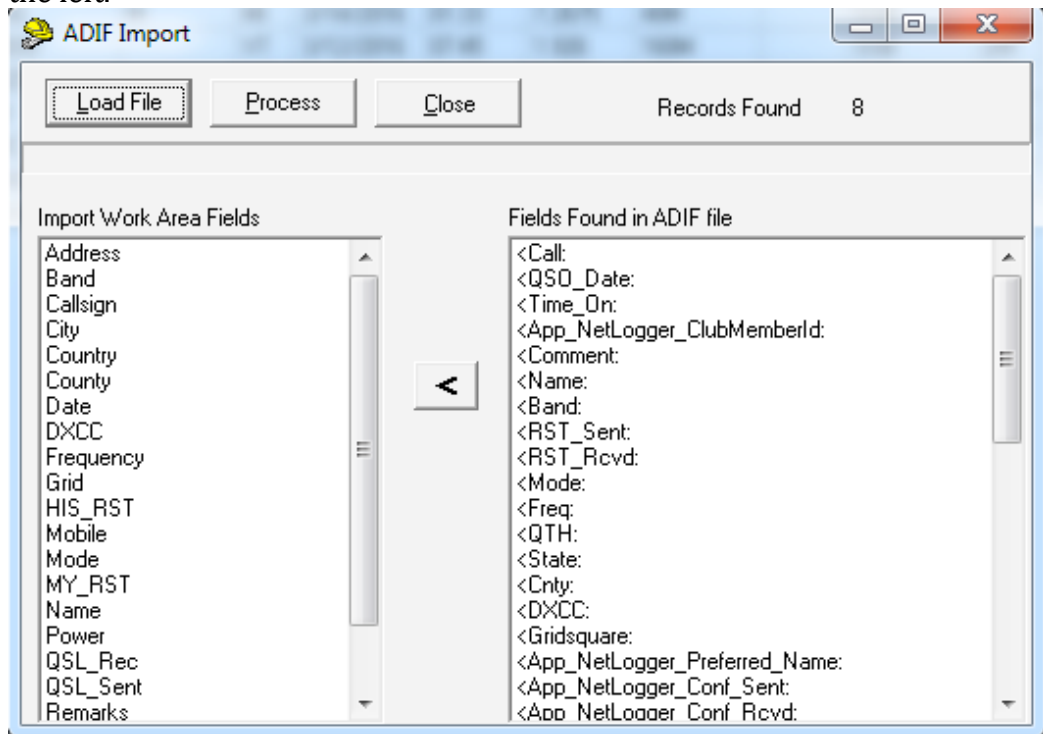
- c. Load your ADIF file by pressing 'Load ADIF'. The ADIF Import window will appear.



- d. Press the 'Load File button' and select the MyContacts.adi file you created in NetLogger. Press 'Open' to continue.



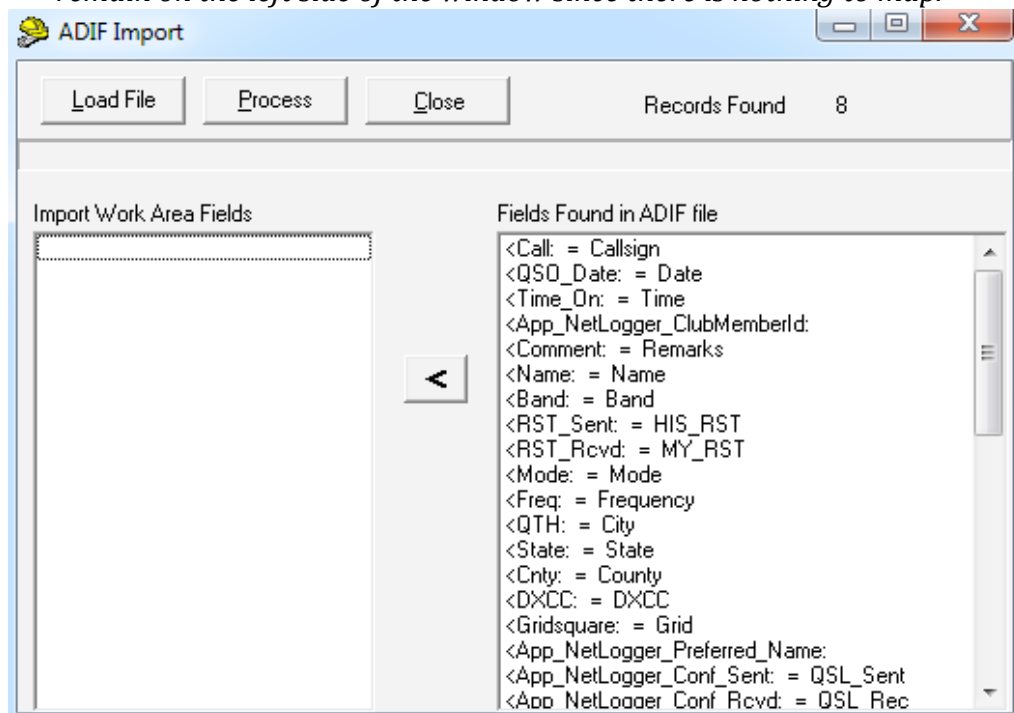
- e. The tags found in your ADIF file will be displayed on the right, and the N7XG fields to which you may import your ADIF data will be shown on the left.



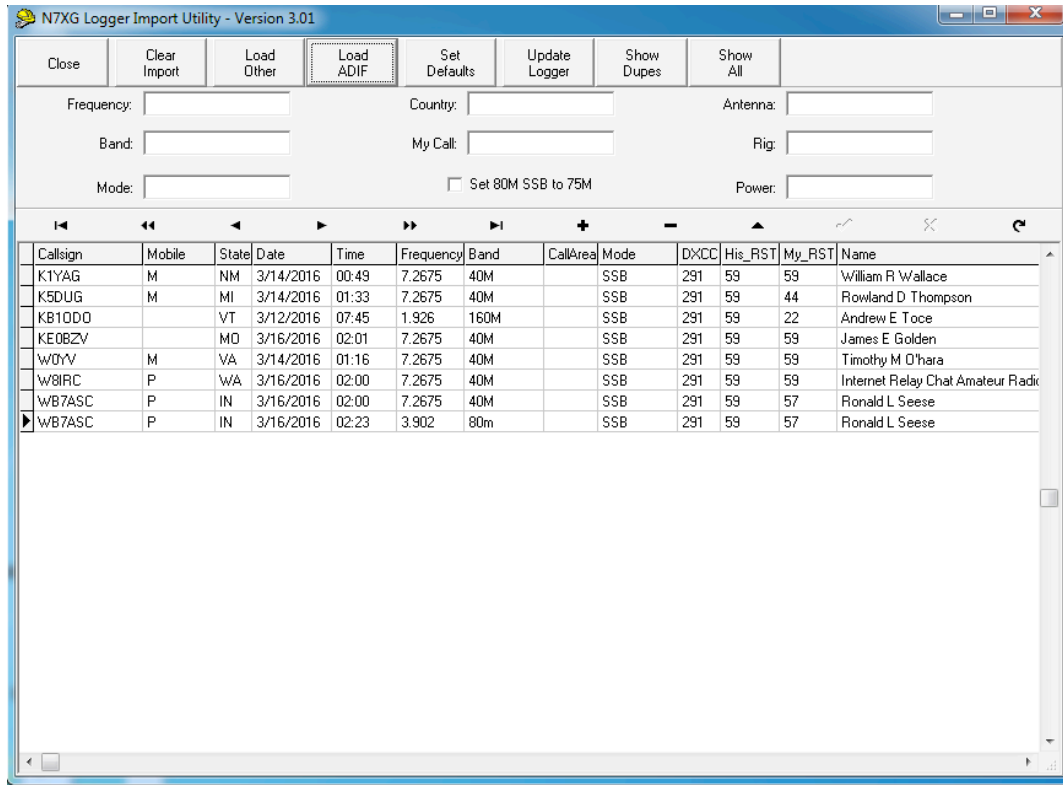
- f. Carefully drag the fields from the left box to the right box as follows:
- Address -> Address
 - Band -> Band
 - Callsign -> Call
 - City -> QTH
 - Country -> Country
 - County -> Cnty
 - Date-> QSO_Date
 - DXCC -> DXCC
 - Frequency -> Freq
 - Grid -> Gridsquare
 - QSL_Sent -> App_NetLogger_Conf_Sent
 - QSL_Rec -> App_NetLogger_Conf_Rcvd
 - HIS_RST -> RST_Sent
 - MY_RST -> RST_Rcvd
 - Mobile -> App_NetLogger_MP_Status
 - Mode -> Mode
 - Name -> Name
 - Remarks -> Comment
 - State -> State
 - Time -> Time_On
 - Power -> TX_PWR

When done, confirm that your window looks like the following picture.

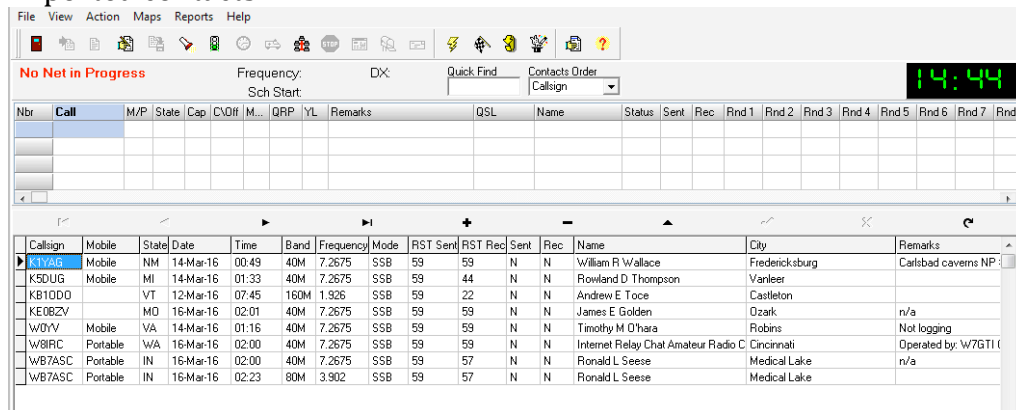
Note: If all your contacts (and associated ADIF file) do not contain information in certain fields (like DXCC or Power) – expect them to remain on the left side of the window since there is nothing to map.



Next, press the 'Process' button, followed by the 'Close' button. Your screen should look like this:



- g. Enter any default values for your contacts like Antenna and Power then press 'Set Defaults'. If your log entries look correct then press 'Update Logger'. Your log entries will be imported into the N7XG Logger. You may now close the Log Conversion Utility.
- h. Open the N7XG Logger. In the lower section of the screen find your newly imported contacts.



- i. Review your newly imported contacts and make any changes or additions required. It is important to note that NOT ALL INFORMATION found in NetLogger, or needed for your club awards may transfer to the N7XG Logger. You will need to make these changes to your imported contacts manually in this screen.
- j. When completed, you may close the N7XG Logger.

Note: for detailed questions about specific functionality of the NetLogger ADIF export or N7XG ADIF import features, please refer to documentation provided with each application.
